VOLUNTEER INCOME TAX ASSISTANCE AT THE CHAVEZ, TRACY, FAIR OAKS, AND WESTON RANCH LIBRARIES The Stockton-San Joaquin County Public Library are partnering with the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program to bring free 2009 income tax assistance.

The VITA program offers free income tax help to low or moderate income families and individuals in San Joaquin County. The libraries also provide income tax forms. These tax assistance programs will be offered from February 2 through April 8, 2010 at the following libraries:

Fair Oaks Branch Library, 2370 E. Main Street, Stockton, on February 10, 17, and March 10, 24 from 11 a.m. until 6:30 p.m.; and

Weston Ranch Branch Library, 1453 W. French Camp Road, Stockton, on February 22 and March 8, 15 from 10 a.m. until 5:30 p.m.
