HISTORY

The DSA is a public/private partnership uniting almost 1,000 property owners and downtown businesses. The DSA was incorporated in 1996 as a 501(c)(6).

The Downtown District was voted into creation in 1997, renewed for a second five-year period in 2002 and most recently for a ten-year period in 2007 by the Stockton City Council with 84.6% of the property owners vote.

PBID

Funded by a Property Based Improvement District (PBID) which allows property owners to self assess on properties providing additional clean and safe, economic development and marketing services to their district and the community.

As we celebrate the 20th year since the founding of the DSA, it's time to recognize the support, direction and persistence provided by this excellent organization. From its inception, the DSA has offered inspiration and direction to downtown property owners, businesses, City and County, and has never wavered from its purpose.
