DSA has a Community Ambassador Team that patrols the Downtown District.

They also perform services like:

- Community Escort Services
- First Call Alarm Program

Business Watch Meetings

Stockton PD's Community Service Department, in partnership with DSA, holds a monthly Downtown Business Watch Meeting at the Stockton Arena, Conference Room A (currently virtual) for stakeholders to share their concerns and hear about solutions. Advocacy

DSA advocates on behalf of Downtown property owners in communications with the SJ Continuum of Care, the SJ County Board of Supervisors, various City of Stockton departments, the Mayor's Office, working groups, and other organizations.

Kiosks

We maintain several QR code kiosks throughout Downtown and the rest of Stockton, which advertises our website, visitor's guide, business map, and events calendar.

Through ARPA funding, we can reimburse you for up to \$800 per window in broken window repairs while funding lasts.

Maintenance

The following maintenance services are performed by the DSA:

- Sidewalk Pressure-Washing
- Sidewalk Spot Treatment
- Litter Abatement
- Sidewalk Trash Can Emptying
- Street-Facing Graffiti Removal
- Sidewalk Weed Removal and Planter Care
- Curb and Bollard Repainting (in partnership with the City of Stockton)

Place-making

DSA has completed several place-making projects to remove blight/beautify Downtown:

- Budd Alley Trash Compactor and Enclosure

- Chung Wah Lane
- Diversity Plaza
- Postcards From Downtown Murals
- Rose Garden Trash Enclosure

Events

DSA also co-hosts various events in Downtown, including Photos with Santa, Main Street Market, and National Night Out.

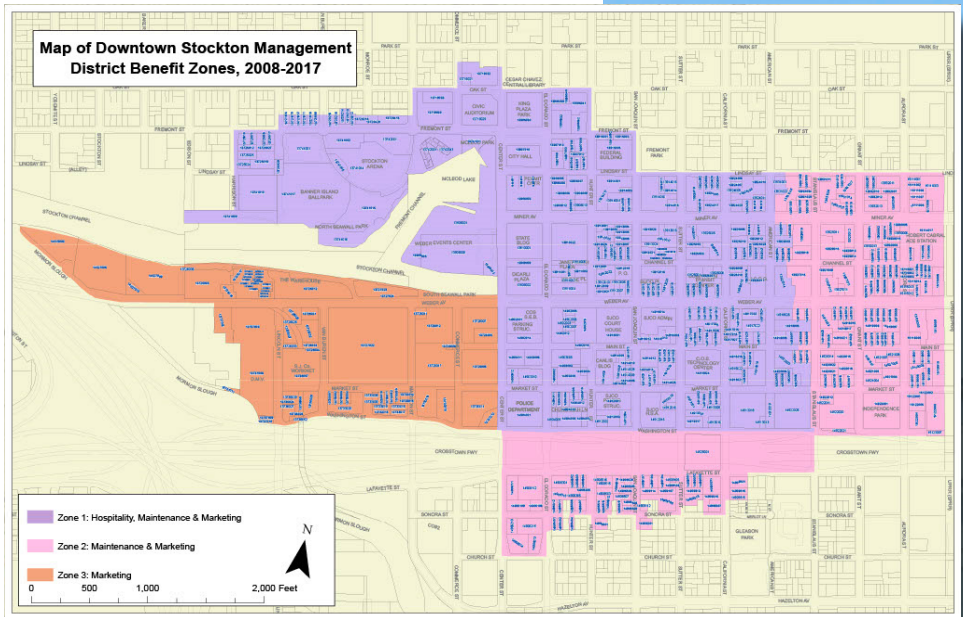
