Downtown Stockton is rich with history, culture, and community. #### Community Ambassador Program

DSA has a Community Ambassador Team that patrols the Downtown District.

They also perform services like:

- Shopping Cart Collection
- Community Escort Services
- First Call Alarm Program

#### Business Watch Meetings

Stockton PD's Community Service Department, in partnership with DSA, holds a monthly Downtown Business Watch Meeting at the Stockton Arena, Conference Room A (currently virtual) for stakeholders to share their concerns and hear about solutions.

#### Advocacy

## Development Zones 1, 2, & 3

### Enewsletters

### Kiosks

We maintain several QR code kiosks throughout Downtown and the rest of Stockton, which advertises our website, visitor's guide, business map, and events calendar.

### Visitor's Guide

We feature Downtown businesses and events in our bi-annual publication handed out to visitors, and displayed in kiosks throughout Stockton.

### New! 1:1 Business Coaching

We now offer 1:1 business coaching for Downtown business owners. Email [cwood@downtownstockton.org](mailto:cwood@downtownstockton.org) for details and to schedule your initial appointment.

### Banner Program

In partnership with the City of Stockton, we lease banner space on antique and standard light poles throughout the district to Downtown businesses and events exclusively.

### DSOLF Loan Program

DSA offers a \$10,000 - \$65,000 loan specifically for Downtown business and property owners who have been turned down by traditional lending institutions.

- Curb and Bollard Repainting (in partnership with the City of Stockton)

- Postcards From Downtown Murals
- Rose Garden Trash Enclosure

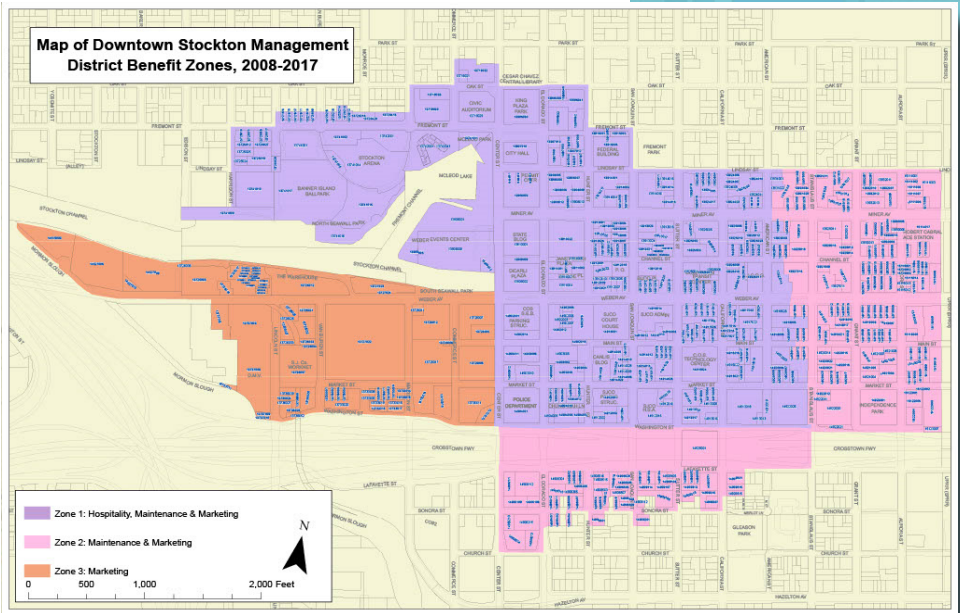
